

Budgeting

Budgeting - Considerations

- ✓ Before starting make sure all your meters are placed correctly within your organization
- ✓ One can create only one budget per year; you can, however, have multiple versions of that budget but only one can be active
- ✓ A budget is produced for everything within your organization
- ✓ Select how many years you want to use for the calculations
- ✓ If you select more than one year you have more options with the data highest, lowest, average scenario
- ✓ Make incremental or significant changes to the budget by using worksheets
- ✓ You are able to force your budget to a single amount


Accrual Bills

Accruals Explained


What are accruals?

- ✓ Accruals are estimated bills that can be used to close out a fiscal period usually used in the first few days of the month
- ✓ Use them to fill in the gap between the end of your most recent bill and the end of your fiscal period
- ✓ However, accrual bills can be created for the future future fill
- ✓ Charts/Graphs automatically <u>exclude</u> accrual bills
