

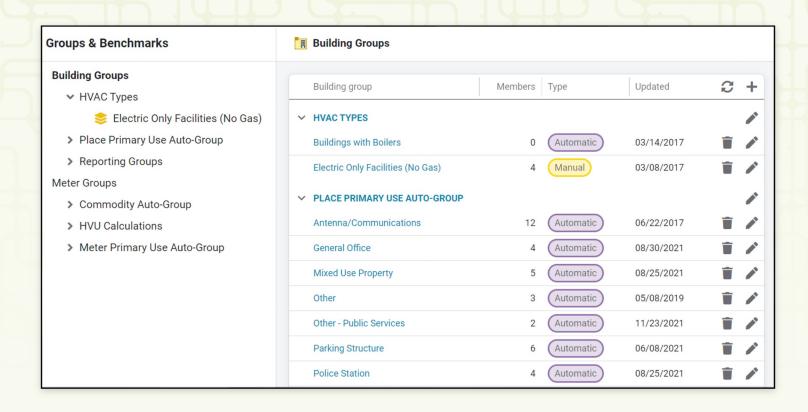

EnergyCAP Groups

Groups help you compare like buildings or meters.

Create your own groups based on attributes important to you.

You can use groups as a filter in dashboards, reports, and bill lists.



Benefits of Groups

Most reports have the filter for building and meter groups.

This has two benefits:

- You can create your own custom groups.
- No need to rely on the tree structure for reporting.



Two Types of Groups

Automatic groups - EnergyCAP automatically assigns membership based on criteria set by user.

Manual groups - You can select the members of the group individually, one-by-one.

Building group	Members Type
City Buildings SQFT > 20000	24 Automatic
Emissions Tracking	32 Manual

Create an Automatic Group

- 1. In the Groups and Benchmarks module, click Building Groups.
- 2. Click the +.
- 3. Enter a name for the group (Your Name's Places > 25,000 Sq Ft)

 Example: Beth Calehuff's Places > 25,000 Sq Ft
- 4. Select a category or add a new category for the group (Your Name's Places). Example: Beth Calehuff's Places
- 5. Decide if all users can see all the buildings in the group even if they don't have topmost permission.
- 6. Click Automatic.
- 7. Add filters to include the specific buildings in the group.
- 8. Click Save & View.

Create a Manual Building Group

- 1. In the Groups and Benchmarks module, click Building Groups.
- 2. Click the +.
- 3. Enter a name for the group. (Your Name's Leased Places)


 Example: Beth Calehuff's Leased Places
- 4. Select a category or add a new category for the group.
- 5. Decide if all users can see all the buildings in the group even if they don't have topmost permission.
- 6. Click Manual.
- 7. Click on the buildings you want to be included in the group.
- 8. Click Save & View.

Create a Custom Field for a Building

- 1. In Buildings & Meters module, click the module menu over the tree view.
- 2. From the dropdown, select Custom Field for Buildings.
- 3. Click the (+) in the top right corner.
- 4. Select **Yes/No** from the dropdown.
- 5. Enter a label for your custom field (Your Name's Favorite Place)


Example: Beth Calehuff's Favorite Place

6. Click **Save**.



Populate Custom Field to Create a Group

- 1. Select a building in your Buildings & Meters hierarchy view.
- 2. Click the **Properties** tab.
- 3. In the Custom Fields box, click Edit.
- 4. Choose (Yes) from the dropdown for your custom field.
- 5. Click Save.




Create an Automatic Group with Custom Fields


